A Bag of Emotions

— JOHN 12:1-26 —

"The next day the large crowd that had come to the feast heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem. So they took branches of palm trees and went out to meet him, crying out, "Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord, even the King of Israel!" And Jesus found a young donkey and sat on it, just as it is written,

"Fear not, daughter of Zion; behold, your king is coming, sitting on a donkey's colt!" (John 12:12-15)

_____ **SERMON NOTES:** _____

With so much emotion circling around Jerusalem, it became easy for people to lose sight of what was going on from God's perspective. How does that affect me? If I allow my emotions, which are good indicators that something is wrong, to go down a bad trail, I'm in trouble. When emotions kick in, I need to begin a process of examining my thoughts, words, and actions; develop a plan; and practice it.

A multitude heard Jesus was in the area and came out to see what was going on. In fact, the religious leaders were so disturbed they said, “the world has gone after him.”

The religious leader's emotions sent them down a bad spiral.

- **Disliked relationship over religious control.**
- **Accusing words, calling him the son of Satan.**
- **Plotting to kill the King.**
- **Paid off a traitor to spy for them.**
- **Physically Abused him.**
- **Publicly Killed him on a Roman cross.**

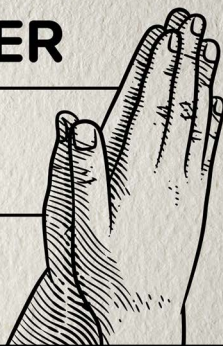
