### What Happens When You Choose to Live for God?

JOHN 11:45-12:12

Mary therefore took a pound of expensive ointment made from pure nard, and anointed the feet of Jesus and wiped his feet with her hair. The house was filled with the fragrance of the perfume. But Judas Iscariot, one of his disciples (he who was about to betray him), said, "Why was this ointment not sold for three hundred denarii[c] and given to the poor?" He said this, not because he cared about the poor, but because he was a thief, and having charge of the moneybag he used to help himself to what was put into it. Jesus said, "Leave her alone, so that she may keep it for the day of my burial. For the poor you always have with you, but you do not always have me." (John 12:3-8)

We are close to the start of Passover and Springtime. Jesus knows his mission will soon be completed. He chose to do God's will, John 18:1; Matthew 26:39, and sets an example for us to live out our lives for God.			
When Jesus had spoken these words, he went out with his disciples across the Kidron Valley, where there was a garden, which he and his disciples entered. And going a little farther he fell on his face and prayed, saying, "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from me, nevertheless, not as I will, but as you will."
