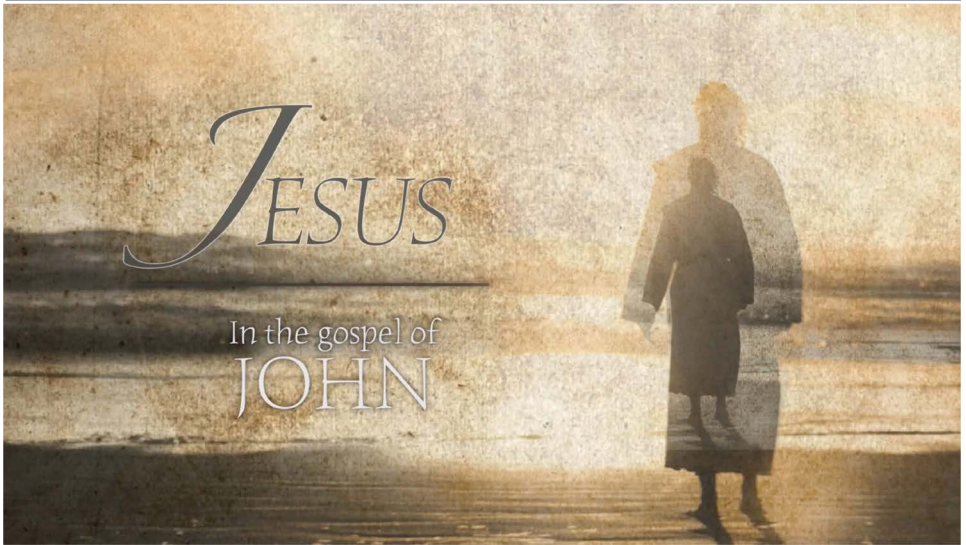

## Green Pastures & Still Waters

JOHN 6:1-21

*"When evening came, his disciples went down to the sea, got into a boat, and started across the sea to Capernaum. It was now dark, and Jesus had not yet come to them. The sea became rough because a strong wind was blowing. When they had rowed about three or four miles, they saw Jesus walking on the sea and coming near the boat, and they were frightened. But he said to them, "It is I; do not be afraid." Then they were glad to take him into the boat, and immediately the boat was at the land to which they were going." (John 6:16-21)*

*Since John's Gospel is selective, he does not record events in the life of Jesus that do not help him fulfill his purpose. Between the healing of the paralytic and the feeding of the 5,000, you have many events taking place, some of which are mentioned in Luke 6:1-9:10 and Mark 3:1-6:30. During this period our Lord preached "the Sermon on the Mount" and gave the parables of the kingdom.*

**Matthew 14:13-33, Mark 6:30-52, Luke 9:10-17, and John 6:1-21**  
record the two occurrences.

**I. Seeing a \_\_\_\_\_ community through Jesus' eyes.**

“A large crowd was constantly following Jesus because they were continually observing his signs,” John 6:2.

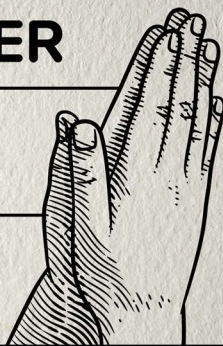
